OCTOBER UPDATE OF HABERGHAM EAVES PARISH COUNCIL DURING THE CORONAVIRUS LOCKDOWN. .

1 Updates

Requests from a parent and also a child to upgrade Buttercross play area were received. The play area is the responsibility of Burnley Borough Council, who do not have the finances. The playground officer has made a plan to extend the life of the climbing unit and balance beams and also to provide some swings. The parish council has agreed to contribute £1,000 towards the work and to look annually at any help which they may be able to give. The work will be undertaken by the borough council as part of its winter works programme.

Coun P Drain organised some tidying up of Fairways Drive with a local contractor and also added moss cleaner to the path. There was concern over a leaning tree. This had been passed to LCC, who are monitoring it.

Burnley Borough Council are to replace a melted bin at the Rossendale Road snack van layby.

Burnley Borough Council has been asked to tidy up the area round the garden. The new planter is to be planted up with heathers.

LCC has put the escape road up for auction after gaining a stopping up order. Auction signs have been put up in the wrong place and the clerk has written to ask for them to be re sited.

Following concerns over hedging blocking the sight lines on Moseley Road, LCC has agreed to flail back.

A resident contacted the parish council over concerns re land behind 109 Glen View Road. This was passed to the borough council and enforcement officer, Karen Morville said planning permission would be required to extend the residential curtilage and the possible engineering/excavation works that appear to have been carried out.

The land is unregistered and the borough council are not sure who owns it. There are currently no TPO's on the land and therefore no consent from the local council is needed to remove the trees, although it may require a licence from The Forestry Commission.
