FEBRUARY 2021 UPDATE OF HABERGHAM EAVES PARISH COUNCIL DURING THE CORONAVIRUS LOCKDOWN. .

1 Updates

Following the grant the parish council received via Councillor Bill Brindle from the Ward Opportunity Fund, Coun. PG Osbaldeston has been working with a local sign maker to create six historical panels which feature local places of interest and a map and which are to be placed along the stone wall in the parish garden. A further £400 has been granted towards the project by the Lancashire County Council Parish Champion.

Complaints have been received from local residents re a blocked gully at the bottom of the farm track at Wilkie Avenue. Both United Utilities and Lancashire County Council have been out to inspect it and any remedial action needed will be taken. The gully is on a reactive programme only, so will only be inspected and cleaned when requested, rather than be on a regular programme of cleaning.

Mr Derek Halstead, the parish lengthsman has retired after 18 years serving the parish . The parish council presented him with a £100 gift voucher for all his hard work. Mr Ed Mountford who lives in the parish is to take over Derek's role.

A resident has requested that the mobile fly tipping monitoring unit owned by BBC is moved to Crown Point/Woodplumpton Road to detract fly tippers targeting this area. The clerk has requested this.

Now a new mobile takeaway unit has been parked on the Rossendale Road layby, residents have asked for the old one to be removed. The parish council has asked for this to be done before, but the owner of the van had a licence to operate from LCC. The clerk to check on the current status.
