### 3. Matters arising from minutes

#### 3.1 Bull and Butcher garden

The modern buttercross is still in the planning stage. The new care home is still being built so the garden is not looking its best, but hopefully once the building has finished, it will be restored to its former glory and maintained by the care home owners, Couns PG Osbaldeston and C Haworth had placed the poppy wreath at the garden on Remembrance Day.

#### 3.2 Fairways Drive ginnel

BBC are to replace the bin. This hasn't been done yet, the clerk to check progress. Following the planting of a rowan tree to mark The Queen's jubilee, a resident had complained re the siting and had offered to pay to move to another site. Councillors had received letters of support and agreed that the species and siting were suitable and voted to leave the tree where it is.

#### 3.3 Project to upgrade pathways and green spaces off Moseley Road

Coun Markarian had met the team working on the project and said it is going to plan and the team had been helpful. She will keep an eye on progress.

#### 3.9 (iv) Noticeboards

The noticeboard off Rossendale Road was tampered with and the posts pulled down. New posts and anti locking nuts have been added and the noticeboard re-erected.

#### 3.9 (v) Gullies at Rossendale Avenue/road

These had been cleaned, but are subject to flooding when the rain is heavy.
