### **3. Matters arising from minutes**

#### **3.1 Bull and Butcher garden**

The garden, planter and trough at The Waggoners are to be weeded and re planted up. BBC has agreed to re site the planter from by the new houses on Rossendale Road, it was suggested to place it in the layby. Costs to re fill and plant the hexagon planters is around £100.

#### **3.2 Tipping at Micklehurst Farm**

#### **3.3 Parking problems at Apex Close and road problems at Moseley Road**

LCC has agreed to launch a formal consultation to explore the possible introduction of parking restrictions and they aimed to have started the work at the end of January. The new parking restrictions require a Traffic Regulation Order, which involves a detailed and lengthy legal process, which can take up to 26 weeks to complete or longer, depending on the outcome of the formal consultation. For this reason, there can't provide a definitive timetable which can resolve the issue. The clerk to check if this has been done.

Re Moseley Road, LCC will look to install new signage to warn drivers of up coming bends on the carriageway. This should also remind drivers to be mindful of their speed and reduce the risk of injury collisions on the road. If

they identify suitable locations to install new signs, they will aim to complete the necessary remedial action as soon as practically possible, but no later than April 2025.
